MEMORANDUM FOR ALMAJCOM (CONTRACTING)

SUBJECT: Implementation of the Cargo Preference Act of 1904 (DAC #88-6, Item XII, dtd March 31, 1989) - ACTION MEMORANDUM

The above DAC was issued March 31, 1989, effective on May 31, 1989. Item XII requires contracting officers to use the clauses at DFARS 252.247-7202 and DFARS 252.247-7203 in solicitations where overseas shipment of supplies will likely occur. It also completely revises the policies at DFARS 247.570 through 247.574.

Your attention is directed to the mandatory requirements at DFARS 247.573-1(d) for submission of a copy of the front page of the DD Form 350 to the U.S. Maritime Administration (MARAD), Department of Transportation. To date MARAD has received less than five DD Form 350s from Air Force buying activities. This may mean our contracting officers have not been accomplishing these requirements to implement the Cargo Preference Act of 1904, 10 U.S.C. 2631.

Request you identify to us by December 15, 1989, a point of contact at the MAJCOM level to monitor compliance. Request you advise this office by January 30, 1989, of actions taken to ensure compliance with these new policies.
